2020 OXFORD 250 CAMPING INFORMATION

Oxford Plains Speedway will re-open our camping line again Friday August 14th between the hours of 10am-1pm only. There is a very limited number of regular camping spots (back parking lot by the pit area only) available for the weekend Thursday through Sunday. There are also VIP spots available on the drag strip.

All those wishing to Camp MUST call to make a reservation. Calls at any other time outside those hours will not be accepted.

Calls are taken, and reservations are booked on a first come first served basis. If you wish, you may leave a voicemail on the camping line only and your call will be returned following the open hours.

- The oversized Parking lot campsites are available for \$100
- The VIP PITSIDE spots on the dragstrip are \$200. All camper in VIP must also purchase a 3 day pit pass
- At this time we are continuing to work with the State of Maine to get more fans in the main grandstands. With current restrictions on spectators we are currently unable to sell front grandstand tickets for the Oxford 250.

Under the current circumstances camping rules will vary from previous years.

- When making reservations, you will commit to a specific arrival day and time and will be unable to arrive at any other time. These times will start Thursday and be available in 15 minute increments between the hours of 8am and 6pm. If you miss your arrival time, your spot may be given to a camper on the waiting list.
- If you commit to a reservation or multiple reservations, you will be expected to honor that commitment even if your circumstance changes. Example, if you book a time for you and 3 others, and one of your party does not show, you will still be expected to cover that fee.
- Self-Cleanup of your site will be expected, carry in carry out. Sites left in excessive disarray may be subject to a fine.
- All campers will be expected to be 100% self-contained and stay within their specific camping area socially distanced. Tents are allowed. This will be patrolled and enforced.
- Personal vehicles will be parked within your designated oversized camping area OR in regular lot
- Campsites will be assigned as campers arrive. We will be unable to accommodate specific spot requests. (if you desire to camp next to a specific person, you should set your reservations to arrive simultaneously) There will be no holding spots.
- ALL campers MUST be parked with hitches facing out so as to form natural social distancing.
- Full registration papers will be posted online in advance. To expedite check-in p and to limit contact we ask that you have all your papers ready to go with exact payment in cash.
- All campers must be removed from the property by 4pm the day following the 250.
